TOWNSHIP OF BYRAM ORDINANCE NO. 26 - 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BYRAM AMENDING CHAPTER 16 THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Purpose Statement: The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 16 of the Township of Byram Code, regulating the Economic Development Committee in the Township of Byram. This Committee advises the Mayor and Council of the Township of Byram and the Township Manager of the Township of Byram in the development of plans, programs and strategies that encourage expansion of existing business and commercial enterprises in the Township of Byram and attract new business and commercial enterprises in the Township of Byram consistent with the goals and objectives of the Sustainable Economic Development Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Byram, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, that the Code of the Township of Byram is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1.

The Code of the Township of Byram is hereby amended to delete and replace existing Chapters 16-1 through 16-7 in their entirety with the following:

Chapter 16. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

16-1. Creation

The Economic Development Committee is hereby created.

§ 16-2. Advisory functions.

The Economic Development Committee shall be advisory to the Township Mayor and Council and the Township Manager.

§ 16-3. Duties.

The duties of the Economic Development Committee shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- A. Development of plans, programs and strategies to encourage the expansion and strengthening of existing business and commercial enterprises in Byram Township, consistent with the goals and objective of the Sustainable Economic Development Plan and conforming to the Township's Master Plan.
- B. Development of plans, programs and strategies for attracting new business and commercial enterprises to the Township of Byram consistent with the goals and objectives of the Sustainable Economic Development Plan of the Township as a whole and conforming to the Township's Master Plan.
- C. Any other studies and/or presentations deemed necessary by Township Mayor and Council and Township Manager relating to the further economic growth and development of the Township.

§ 16-4. Intermunicipal activities.

The Economic Development Committee shall provide representation with the Sussex County Economic Development Partnership, Sussex County Chamber of Commerce and any other appropriate county, regional or state economic development activities.

§ 16-5. Appointment of members; composition terms;

The Economic Development Committee shall be appointed annually by the Township Council and shall be comprised of five to nine members of the general public including a member of the Township Council and the Planning Director or his/her designee.

§ 16-6. Organization.

The Economic Development Committee shall organize itself in a manner that shall ensure the most efficient carrying out of its assigned tasks. The EDC shall elect a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and Secretary from among the members of the Committee.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance to the extent it can be given effect, or the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby, and to this extent the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. REPEALER.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final adoption and publication as required by law.

TOWNSHIP OF BYRAM ORDINANCE NO. 27-2016 AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND RATIFY THE ABANDONMENT OF SEWAGE PUMP STATION EASEMENT AND PRIVATE TRANSFER OF PUBLIC PROPERTY (EASEMENT) NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE

PURPOSE STATEMENT: The purpose of this Ordinance of the Township of Byram ("Township" or "Byram") is to authorize abandonment and relinquishment of and ratify the unnecessary easement and sewage pump station and related pipes and improvements ("sewage pump station") on the former Community Center property known and designated as Block 226, Lot 21 and located at 55 Lackawanna Drive in the Township ("the subject property"). The sewage pump station and easement are no longer required or used by the Township and are only useful for the property, and the Township, by this Ordinance, is abandoning the easement and sewage pump station and relinquishing same to the new title owner of record of the property, 55 Lackawana Development, LLC ("Developer"), a limited liability company owned and managed by Mr. Gerard Simeone ("Simeone"). The Township had reserved an easement on the property when it sold the subject property to Simeone by Deed dated December 4, 2012 (attached hereto as Exhibit A), and pursuant to Township Ordinance No. 3-2012.

WHEREAS, the Township reserved the easement set forth in item 1, below, and said easement is no longer needed or required for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Township of Byram have deemed it in the best interest of the Township to transfer this property by private transfer to the owner of the property in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b)(4), and any and all other applicable statutes, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the reservation of easement is set forth in the attached Deed, dated December 4, 2012, attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Byram, Sussex County, New Jersey, that:

Section 1. General Terms and Conditions.

1. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 230 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Purpose Statement: An amendment to 230-59 is necessary to correct the zone districts specified in the ordinance.

Whereas, during an ordinance review, an error was found 230-59, with regard to the zone names; and

Whereas, Byram Township hereby amends this section to reflect the correct districts.

SECTION 1.

Chapter 230, Article VII. Traffic Regulations Applicable to Semipublic and Private Areas shall be revised as follows:

230-59. Parking vehicles for sale or lease prohibited in the B-1, B-2, VC and ICP Districts shall be deleted and replaced with:

230-59. Parking vehicles for sale or lease prohibited in the VB, VC, NC and IPR Districts.

Section A shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

A. No vehicle shall be parked in the VB Village Business District (240-56), VC Village Center District (240-59), NC Neighborhood Commercial District (240-57) or IPR Industrial Professional Recreational District (240-60) of the Township by its owner or with his/her knowledge for the purpose of offering it for sale or lease except as otherwise permitted as an accessory to an automotive sale, service or repair business on the same lot. This section shall not apply to a registered vehicle owned by the owner or tenant of the property or by a person lawfully doing business on the property.
