- Alternative Systems –Waiting to hear back from John Eskilson at the County. Joan said that she would check with him to see what information he has. John Cubberly suggested that he would like to get a letter from Mr. Eskilson stating whether or not the County will be monitoring the Alternative Systems.
- Phosphorus Free Ordinance – Post-pone any further discussion on this matter until next Board of Health Meeting to discuss further. Not all Board of Health Members are 100% on board with passing an ordinance that they feel cannot be policed. Daven expressed a different opinion on this stating that not everything can be 100% policed however if there is an ordinance in place more people will be inclined to follow it. A suggestion was made to research and get addition information to further this discussion in November. John will call Chemlawn to see how they manage townships with PF ordinances, Emily volunteered to call True Green and Joan Skillan will be calling the state to see how they regulate licensed companies. Cindy will look into getting a copy of the Lake Mohawk Phosphorus Free Ordinance.
- 200 feet Notification for Septic Repairs / Replacements Ordinance –David Soloway (Twp. Attorney) came to the meeting and reflected his comments on the proposed ordinance. He found some things that he would suggest changing. BOH will discuss this in November and will forward what they want this ordinance to address to David to draft.
- Highlands Municipal Ordinance discussion – The Board addressed the public on their thoughts and happenings with the Highlands Municipal Ordinance.
- Welcome to our newest BOH member – Daven Baez was sworn in and welcomed as the newest BOH member.
- Report(s) from the County. Joan reported on Timbers, they would need to redesign the plan for the grease trap flow. CAD had exceeded levels of Total Coliform and will need to follow further NJ State standards. NJ Bar & Grill moved their dumpster.
- PAC meeting minutes – Mimi gave a brief run down on the happening at the PAC meeting.
