DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Byram Township Manager, Joseph Sabatini attended the Board of Health meeting to discuss a previous meeting that he and Cindy Church attended with Emrick Seabold and Denise Webb of the Sussex County Health Department on March 16, 2015. The discussion was on how to move forward with septic applications. As a result of that meeting the following was agreed upon:

- Sussex County Health Department will send weekly reports (on Thursdays) on new and altered septic systems. These records can be emailed to Cindy at cchurch@byramtwp.org. These reports are going to include the status, what kind of work is being done, and the block, lot and address. It will also include a reference on the reports as to what systems obtained or will need to obtain a GP25 or TWA permit.
- The Sussex County Health Department will be sending a copy of the GP25 and TWA permits with the monthly packets that are sent to the Township.
- Going forward the Sussex County Health Department will no longer approve septic permit applications until the GP25 or TWA permits have been approved by the state. Copies of such permits will be kept and sent to the Township with the plans.

Joe suggested that the Board of Health continue to review their ordinances, but to also consider coming up with a way to define “New Construction” as it has to do with septic installations.

Review of Local Board of Health Ordinance – A motion was made by Bill Schenkel and Seconded by Ruth Rhodes to table the review of Chapters: 272, 274, 277 & 283 to the May 2015 meeting.

PLANNING BOARD REVIEWS

The Board of Health reviewed the plans for 13 North Shore Trail West, Block 182 Lot 43. There were no comments.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Annual Rabies Clinic will be held on April 18, 2015 from 9am to 12 noon. We anticipate receiving 400 vaccines from the state; however, there is word that there may be a shortage.
