**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

**Review of Local Board of Health Ordinance** – Upon extensive review of the local board of health ordinances (Chapters 245, 248, 254, 257), the board decided that there was so much that had to be corrected that would go beyond what can be done during the course of the meeting. Scott suggested obtaining the Board of Health Ordinances from Sparta, Vernon and Hardyston. Cindy will get copies to distribute.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**County Report-** Anita reported on the following:

All lake and bathing facilities throughout the township have been inspected.

Byram Diner - The Nitrate problem has been resolved.

Lockwood Tavern – Lockwood obtained the Serve Safe Certificate, and will be installing a hand washing sink outside of the kitchen because the kitchen does not have an area to put it.

Frankies on the Lake (formerly Down to the Bone) – has reactivated the water and has now re-opened. A T1 permit was also obtained from because the septic usage is more than 2000 gallons per day.

An infiltrator system was installed at a property on Birch Parkway; Anita did not have the actual location at the time.

**EPA Superfund Site update** – Scott reported on the meeting of the Mansfield Trail Group. Three wells were drilled. One of the wells had come back with high levels of PCE, and then tested again later showing no signs of PCE. There are plans to drill 7 additional wells that will be dug deeper than the residential wells in that area, and will then do sample testing. They plan to have the Record of Determination completed by 2016.

**Radon Test Devices** – Cindy reported that the Radon tests have been delivered and are ready for Byram Day.
