BYRAM TOWNSHIP RABIES CLINIC:

The annual Rabies Clinic was held on April 8, 2017 from 9am to 12 noon. 153 dogs and 21 cats from Byram and 24 nonresident animals were vaccinated at the clinic.

SEPTICE MANAGEMENT:

275 reminders letters to pump septic systems were mailed dated June 23 with a compliance date of October 1, 2017

POLICY ADVISOR COMMITTEE (PAC) :

Don Bogardis stated that his letter of appointment was not received; however he was able to attend the meeting. The problem has since been resolved. Pertaining to our area he reported that other towns in the vicinity of Musconetcong Sewage Plant have also been receiving complaints of the odor coming from the plant.

SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE: (SWAC)

Bill Kolhoffer resigned. No report.

Shelia Pepe requested a schedule be emailed to her.

SUSSEX COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH DEPT:

- Dennis Webb stated that there has been an influx of septic repairs, new and alternative septic systems in the Township.

- On May 1st Stonewood Tavern did not have water. Problem stems back to April 6 when the well pump failed. Facility was closed during the repair. Proper well chlorination and water samples must be met.
- Orchard Garden, Lackawanna Drive has closed.
- Cranberry Lake Beach was closed on 7/3 due to not submitting water samples. Water samples taken on 7/11, the beach remained closed while samples were processed, opened on 7/13.
- Rose Beach on North Shore Trail failed twice for bacteria.
- Water samples are required once a week. Inspections occur when there are missing water samples, a failure or fatality.
- Nutrition Zone has Conditional Satisfactory rating. Sanitizer and test strips required.
- Halulu Hibachi & Sushi have a Satisfactory rating. Reinspection showed that various repairs were completed. Sushi case temperatures were fine. Given 3 months to replace the mop sink and 6 months to paint the back storage room.
- Residents from 28 Ash Street and 38 Acorn Street made complaints on rats being on their property. There was evidence that a rat had chewed threw a garbage can which was stored in an attached structure. Slight gap near structure door will be closed. Visual inspections of catch basins, the over grown water retention basin, and residential properties show no cause or findings at this time.

PENDING BUSINESS:

Ordinances Updated: Prior work is still in a pending status. Anthony Ansaldi will review past minute and notes and will report back.

NEW BUSINESS:

Byram Day is scheduled for September 9 between the hours of 11:00 am to 5:00pm. Board of Health will share a table together with the Environmental Commission. Bernie Rogalski will man the table and will distribute Radon coupons which will be turned in at the Township building in exchange for a Radon Kit.
