- Municipal Building Subcommittee Update – Harvey pointed out that the proposed OPMA law would require 4 quarterly reports per year on a subcommittee meeting, and the oral report he is giving tonight would count towards that. They had their second meeting, and the committee was created about 1 month ago. The committee is looking at leasing/purchasing, rehabbing our building or building a new building. Today they visited the Andover police department, and on Thursday they will visit Lafayette. They may look at Pope John’s pre-fab building. The committee is meeting with the Byram Board of Education next week to discuss repurposing the open space area for municipal space. The Andover Police Department tour was very interesting. The subcommittee will be meeting tomorrow morning at Senator Oroho’s office to discuss private/public partnership legislation.
