Call meeting to order, Meeting opened at 8:00pm

- Minutes from September 21, 2020 – Motion by Scott Yappen, second by Jeri Quirk to approve the minutes. Motion passed

- Holiday Events (Tree Lighting, Decorating Contest, etc)
 - The Fire Department will be hosting a no contact drive-in tree lighting.
 - The mailbox for Letters to Santa can be setup at the Municipal Building starting December 1.
 - Santa will still wave from the fire truck and drive around but probably won't give out candy canes.
 - The governor has not changed the max number of people allowed at an event. Nicole shared that Newton is still holding their tree lighting and photos with Santa. The Committee decided not have photos with Santa.
 - Motion by Jeri Quirk and second by Bob Androsky to start the light contest on December 1 with gift card prizes of \$100 for first place, \$75 for second place, and \$50 for third place. Approved by all
 - The light contest will end December 10 and Phil will send the addresses to the Committee. Judging will be the weekend of 12/12 and 12/13. The winners will be announced at the Council meeting on 12/15. Phil will advertise the flyer on the Township website and Facebook. Jeri asked if we could purchase gift cards from local restaurants. Phil will ask.

- School Sign
