Applicant is bound by representations made in this application. Any changes to operations are subject to further review prior to implementation. Failure to comply with any conditions of approval will render a permit invalid, and all privileges and relief granted shall be revoked, until new authorization is obtained. Temporary permits ultimately expire on January 1, 2021 unless extended or terminated by the Mayor and Council.
