All,

I am starting the process to get organized to discuss the Township's Capital Program with the Mayor and Council.

Please reference the information below on the Capital Budget and the Capital Improvement Fund.

Under the Local Budget Law the Governing Body is required to adopt a capital budget and a 3-year capital improvement program in conjunction with the annual operating budget.

I need each department head to provide a complete listing of all known capital items (improvements, equipment, vehicles, etc.) with a description of need, estimated cost and prioritization. Do not restrict to the next three years. I minimally want a five-year schedule for replacement of vehicles and equipment.

See Information below on Capital Budget and the proposed Capital Improvement Fund: Capital Budget:

Local Budget Law 40A:4-43 – Capital Budgets, definition.: The governing body may and shall, when directed by the local government board, prepare, approve and adopt a budget for the expenditure of public funds for capital purposes to give effect to general improvement programs. A capital budget shall be a plan for the expenditure of public funds for capital purposes, showing as income the revenues, special assessments, free surplus, and down payment appropriations to be applied to the cost of a capital project or projects, expenses of issuance of obligations, engineering supervision, contracts and any other related expenditures.

· The Governing Body is required to adopt a capital budget and a capital improvement program in conjunction with its annual operating budget.

- The capital budget represents *the current year* of a three capital improvement program since the Township is under a 10,000 population.
- · The capital improvement program presents the schedule for capital projects showing projected costs and revenue sources.
- · The capital budget DOES NOT in itself confer any authority to raise or expend funds.
- · The Governing Body is not responsible for preparing the capital budget for capital improvement program. The responsibility may be assigned to the administrative staff or the Planning Board, or both. Final content of the plan resides with the Governing Body.
- · Municipal Land Use Law permits the Governing Body to request the Planning Board to prepare the proposed capital program. The Land Use Law states that if there is an adopted master plan, the Planning Board must be given 45 days to review any "action necessitating the expenditure of any public fund" affecting the master plan.
- · In Byram Township, it has been the responsibility of the Administrative Staff to prepare the capital budget and capital improvement program.

Capital Improvement Fund:

- · Within the general fund under general appropriations there is a provision for Capital Improvement appropriations.
- · This is for appropriations that have a useful life of 5 years or more.
- · The fund permits appropriations to be set aside for purposes that may not be known or specified at time of the budget adoption.
- · Municipalities annually may appropriate a fixed sum to this fund permitting it to build up over several years.
- · No money may be expended from the Capital Improvement Fund without an ordinance being adopted for a specific purpose.
- The capital improvement fund is used as a means of financing down payments for ordinance appropriations. All bondable capital items must have a minimum 5% down payment.

Please see the below 5-year vehicle replacement plan for the police department. Thank you.

2026 -

- o Replace detective car 2, 2019 Ford F-150 with a purchase in 2026
- o Move detective car 2, 2019 Ford F-150 to back line.
- o Take back line car 3, 2016 Tahoe out of service.

2027 -

- o Replace primary car 8, 2022 Tahoe with 2027 purchase.
- Move primary car 8, 2022 Tahoe to back line.
- o Take back line car 5, 2020 Ford Explorer out of service.
- If a second vehicle can be purchased in 2027, the Chief's vehicle, car 1, 2020 Dodge Durango will be made an admin/back line vehicle and replace car 2, 2019 Ford F-150. The plan will be adjusted accordingly at that time if necessary.

2028 -

- o Replace primary car 7, 2023 Tahoe with 2028 purchase.
- Move primary car 7, 2023 Tahoe to back line.
- Take back line car 6, 2018 Ford Explorer out of service.

2029 -

- Replace primary car 5, 2023 Tahoe with 2029 purchase.
- o Move primary car 5, 2023 Tahoe to back line.
- Take back line old-old car 7, 2018 Ford Explorer out of service.

2030 -

- o Replace primary car 6, 2023 Tahoe with 2030 purchase.
- o Move primary car 6, 2023 Tahoe to back line.
- Take back line car 2, 2019 Ford F-150 out of service. Or, take car 1, 2020
 Dodge Durango out of service if car 2, 2019 Ford F-150 is already gone.
