## NEWS ON BYRAM TOWNSHIP'S RECYCLING PROGRAM

**Introducing RECYCLE COACH!** Not sure how to dispose of a specific item? "Ask" Recycle Coach to get the specifics! Use the link on the Township website from the Garbage and Recycling page, or download the app and access the information from your mobile devices. Set up an Email reminder so you won't forget the recycling days and/or export the data to your calendar.

Items which can be **recycled at the Twp. Recycling Center** include leaves, brush and metals. The Twp. Recycling Center is open 7 days a week during daylight hours, weather dependent. Please check our website, [www.byramtwp.org](http://www.byramtwp.org), for additional details, including recycling special events!

- **Leaves and Brush Less than 4" in Diameter** - leaves must be disposed of in biodegradable paper bags or loose; NO plastic bags are permitted. This area will be closed from mid Dec. through the end of Mar. due to winter weather. However, there is the possibility that this area may close earlier than mid Dec. and/or may not open till late April as this is dependent upon the weather. Please call the Township to confirm open/closure dates.
- **Metals** - appliances, microwaves, air conditioners, grills, exercise equipment, etc.

**Special Items - Curbside Pick Up** which includes **Christmas Trees** (Mon., Jan. 7) and **Leaves in Biodegradable Paper Bags** (will be picked up in the Fall, weather dependent). Please check our website for details.

**Additional items** can be recycled at Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority for a nominal fee or during scheduled fee free days. Details can be found on the Township website or [scmua.org](http://scmua.org).
