It is highly encouraged for all other skiers/riders to take at least one lesson. This form must clearly state your skier's/rider's ability level. **Helmets are MANDATORY!**

Mountain Creek season passes, lift tickets and rentals are purchased online directly from Mountain Creek. Prices and information are provided in this packet and online.

The cost of the bus for all 5 trips to Mountain Creek is \$85 and is payable to Byram Township Recreation.

I hereby grant permission for my child/myself to participate in the Byram Township Ski/rider Club and assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation. I waive and release all rights and claims for damages against Byram Township, Byram Schools, Lenape Valley Regional High School, their employees, officers, staff, sponsors, volunteer chaperones and other participants for all injuries that may be suffered by the herein named minor or myself while participating in the program. I realize that my children's academics are a priority and will schedule his/her time appropriately. I understand that all fees are not refundable without a physician's note stating that the participant is unable to participate in the program. I recognize that Byram Township Parks and Recreation programs are governed by a set of rules and regulations, and I agree to conduct myself in accordance therewith and to exercise my influence where appropriate on those for whom I am responsible in order to encourage proper conduct and decorum. I also give permission for Byram Parks and Recreation to make non-commercial use of any activity photographs or video of my child/myself.

I understand that I am liable for any expenses incurred for injuries sustained in Ski/Ride Club participation. If my child /I require emergency treatment, I give my permission and hereby designate trip advisors and chaperones as my agent to contact Ski Patrol and/or EMS as deemed necessary.

My child and I both understand that he/she is required to observe all rules set down by the Ski/Ride Club and ski areas. Any breach of rules will result in the student being sent home immediately, at the parent's expense, and expulsion from the club without reimbursement.

Realizing that participation in skiing/riding involves the potential for injury, which is inherent in all recreational activities, I acknowledge that even with the best instruction, use of the most protective equipment and strict observance of rules, injuries are still a possibility. Ski helmets are **MANDATORY**. On rare occasions these injuries can be so severe as to result in total disability, paralysis or even death. Moreover, the parent and/or guardian realize that the ski advisors/chaperones will not be with your children on the ski slopes and that they are not ski instructors.

Byram Township Ski/Ride Club Contract

This contract is an agreement between you, your advisors and chaperones and the rest of the ski/ride club members. Please read over this carefully and sign below!

- I. I will learn and obey the Responsibility Code and Safety Tips
- II. I agree to follow the Byram Ski/ride Club Rules
 - a. **I WILL ALWAYS SKI OR RIDE WITH A PARTNER**
 - b. I will not ski/ride on a slope until I have had an instructor's permission (I understand that all black diamond trails are off limits to novice skiers or riders)
 - c. I will not smoke, vape, drink alcohol, use drugs or abusive language on any ski/ride outing
 - d. I will not eat or drink on the bus
 - e. I will always speak courteously to club advisors, chaperones, other members and mountain staff
 - f. I will respect the rights and safety of others and always consider them and their property
 - g. I will take at least two lessons if I am a beginner (it is highly encouraged for all others to take at least one lesson).
 - h. I will encourage other ski/ride members to obey safety rules and will present a positive attitude always.
 - i. I will follow the dress code, helmet, gloves and dress warmly
 - j. I will obey school rules and procedures throughout the entire trip
 - k. I will be ready to board the bus to return home at 8:30 pm.
- III. I understand and will abide by all the conditions set forth on the Ski and Board Information Sheet
- IV. Violations of any of these rules will result in suspension from one or all the ski/ride trips, depending upon the severity of the violation. I understand that if I am suspended from a trip, I will NOT receive a refund for any missed trips.

I understand the contract and agree with its principles and will do my best to abide by it.

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Byram Township Ski/Ride Club Rules

- 1). NO SKIING/RIDING ON DAYS THAT SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED.
- 2). DO NOT CALL THE SCHOOL TO SEE IF SKI/RIDE CLUB IS CANCELLED.
- 3). **Ski helmets are mandatory for all skiers/riders.**
- 4). Students not in school may not attend the ski/ride trip for that day.
- 7). Bus leaves Lenape HS at 3:15 pm and Byram Intermediate at 3:35 pm.
- 8). Bus returns to Byram Intermediate at 9:15 pm and Lenape HS at 9:30 pm. Parents must be at the school to pick up their child.
- 9). Dress appropriately with warm clothing including hats, gloves, etc.
- 11). All injuries, no matter how slight, must be reported to the trip advisors or chaperones.
- 12). Beginner skiers/riders must not go to the top of the slopes until approved by instructors or advisors.
- 13). Check your equipment before going skiing or riding – especially the bindings.
- 14). Buy a lock to secure your own skis or board. Renters are also responsible for their equipment.
- 15). **Never ski or ride without a partner.**
- 17). Students must return rental equipment by 8:15pm.
- 18). No smoking, including vaping, alcohol or drugs allowed.
- 19). Intermediate students will be dismissed from homerooms to change into ski/ride clothes by an announcement. HS students may change in the locker rooms at the end of the school day if they are available otherwise, they will need to change in the restrooms.
- 20). Once dismissed and dressed, all Intermediate School students must remain in the cafeteria until the bus arrives.
- 21). HS students meeting place is the Football Field side of the gym.
- 22). Misbehavior or violation of the club contract may result in expulsion from the ski/riding club with no refund.
- 23). All rules and regulations of the skiing/riding area, ski patrol and rangers must be obeyed.
- 24). Parents may drop off ski/boards at the school in the morning or before trip departure. Skis/boards may be stored on the stage in the All Purpose Room at the Intermediate School. **High School...TBD.**
- 25). There are no refunds without a note from a physician indicating inability to participate in the program.
- 26). Know your responsibility code. **BE AWARE... SKI OR RIDE WITH CARE!**
