

Byram Township Senior Transportation Update

Effective November 4, 2020 Byram Township senior transportation services will be temporarily suspended.

Accordingly, Byram Township seniors are encouraged to utilize the Sussex County Skylands Ride service for their transportation needs.

- Skylands Ride Transportation service is provided for a requested \$1.50 donation each way.
- Seniors are encouraged to call Skylands Ride and preregister for their service prior to scheduling their first trip.
- Reservations for transportation must be made at least 2 business days in advance of your appointment.
- Skylands Ride goes to Byram Shop-Rite on Thursdays and will usually pick up seniors around 9:30 am and then return them home around 12:00 pm
