Blue Diamond handles our garbage and recycling needs. ReCommunity Recycling reimburses the Township for the sale of residential collected recyclables every year.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. When is trash picked up?

Every Tuesday* between 6am and 6pm at curbside. Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 6am on Tuesday <u>or</u> after 5pm on Monday night. After collection, containers must be removed by 7pm on Tuesday.

*unless there is a holiday or inclimate weather in which case, attempts are made to pick up on the next day except on Sunday

2. Am I limited to the number of containers I put out each week?

We are permitted up to two (2) 45 gallon containers each week, each weighing no more than 40 lbs.

3. What types of items can I put out?

In addition to solid waste, we are permitted one (1) bulk item per week (ex. sofa, chair, dresser, mattress, desk, carpet, treadmill, etc.).

4. What is SCMUA?

The Sussex County Municipal Authority (SCMUA) is the county landfill. SCMUA accepts solid wastes, recycling, bulk waste, e-waste, etc. Residents can bring their waste to this facility Monday through Saturday from 7am to 2pm (located at 34 South Route 94, Lafayette, NJ 07848). Please note that disposal fees may be charged, unless there is a special designated free day for specific materials, such as e-waste or hazardous materials. SCMUA will establish several of these special days per year. For additional SCMUA information, click here for their website or call 973-579-6998 (Monday through Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm).
