

2026 BYRAM TOWNSHIP GARBAGE & RECYCLING INFORMATION

GARBAGE PICK-UP / CURBSIDE Service provided by Blue Diamond (973) 598-9800 Mondays – Fridays 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.	Every Tuesday* between 6 a.m./6 p.m. at curbside. Trash must be placed curbside no later than 6 a.m. on Tuesdays, OR trash may be placed curbside after 5 p.m. the preceding day (Mondays).
	After collection, all containers must be removed by 7 p.m. on the day of collection.
	Up to two (2) 45-gallon containers per week are permitted, each weighing no more than 40 lbs.
	*Unless inclement weather prohibits regular pick-up, in which an attempt will be made to pick up the following day (except Sundays). If on a holiday, pick-up will occur the following day. Please be patient as there may be delays due to extra volume.
WHAT IS PICKED UP CURBSIDE	One (1) Bulk Item per week (sofa, chair, dresser, mattress, desk, carpets rolled in <6' sections, exercise equipment such as treadmill ONLY if less than 50% metal, etc.).
	Christmas Trees will be picked up mid-January (date published on Township website). Please ensure all lights, decorations and tinsel are removed.
	Household Batteries Only – Alkaline, zinc-carbon and zinc-chloride (heavy duty) batteries may be disposed with regular trash.
	Medical Waste (Sharps/Needles/Liquids) – Place used sharps/needles/liquids in puncture resistant, leak-proof sharps container or heavy-duty plastic container (laundry detergent bottle). Close screw-on lid tightly, label container "Do Not Recycle – Contains Sharps" . Put plastic container in household trash. DO NOT RECYCLE!
WHAT IS NOT PICKED UP CURBSIDE	Items that may be recycled. Click here for link. #6 Foam Packaging (no clamshells or cups) may be brought to SCMUA. #4 Plastic Shopping Bags, Dry Cleaning Bags may be brought to most Wal-Mart, Acme, Stop & Shop, Kohl's, Target and Lowe's stores. These bags may also be accepted at SCMUA. Medications – Pills, tablets and capsules may be recycled at the Byram Twp. Police Dept. (See SCMUA's website for hospital drop-off locations.)

Hazardous Waste (paints, oils, chemicals, insecticides, pesticides, driveway sealers, fluorescent light bulbs, etc.) – SCMUA designates special free Hazardous Waste Disposal Days during the year. <i>Note: Motor oil and antifreeze (up to 5 gallons) may be brought year-round to SCMUA at no charge.</i>
	Construction Materials (concrete, Sheetrock, tiles, wood, toilets, sinks, vanities, siding, flooring, shingles, siding, gutters, windows, railroad ties, etc.) may be brought year-round to SCMUA for a nominal disposal fee.
	#5 Rigid Plastics (patio furniture, household plastic items such as storage containers, tubs, shelving, milk crates, plastic toys - Little Tykes, Big Wheels, plastic buckets) may be brought to SCMUA for a nominal disposal fee.
	Other Items – Car/boat/lawn tractor/rechargeable batteries, air conditioners, flags, cell phones, etc. may be brought year-round to SCMUA for a nominal disposal fee.

Leaf and Brush area closed winter months	Metals – Appliances such as stoves, dishwashers, microwaves, etc. Grills are accepted at the Recycling Center after propane tanks have been removed. <i>(Propane tanks are not accepted in Byram but may be brought to SCMUA for a disposal fee).</i>
	Auto Tires (no rims) – 7 days a week year-round (daylight hours)
	Leaves – Although leaves placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up curbside during special Leaf Pick-up Days (see website for dates), only residents (NOT contractors) may bring leaves to the Twp. Recycling Center when Leaf/Brush area is open during daylight hours 7 days a week. Note that this area is monitored with security cameras 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. This area is typically closed mid-December through end of March due to winter weather conditions. However, this area may close earlier than mid-December and/or may not open till late April (weather-dependent). Please call Township to confirm dates area will close and open. Grass clippings are NOT accepted and must be brought to SCMUA.
	Brush – Brush/branches less than 4" in diameter can be brought to the Twp. Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open. See "Leaves" for dates/times. Note Brush is a separate area from leaves. Grass Clippings are NOT accepted and must be brought to SCMUA.
