

BYRAM TOWNSHIP RECYCLING INFORMATION

<p>RECYCLING PICK-UP / CURBSIDE: Service provided by Blue Diamond, (973) 598-9800</p>	<p>Every other Friday*, at curbside, between 6am and 6pm. Containers must be placed curbside by 6am on the scheduled pick-up day, OR may be placed curbside after 5pm on the preceding day.</p> <p>After collection, all containers must be removed by 7pm of the day of collection.</p> <p>Recyclables can be mixed together in the same containers (do not put them in plastic bags) and there is no limit to the number of containers used. Shredded paper must be in clear plastic bags only.</p> <p>* unless incimate weather prohibits the regular pick-up, in which an attempt will be made to pick up the following day (not on Sundays). If on a holiday, the pick-up will occur the following day. Please be patient as there may be delays due to extra volume.</p>
<p>WHAT IS PICKED UP CURBSIDE:</p>	<p>Glass - food and beverage jars and bottles.</p> <p>Plastic Containers - stamped with #1, 2 and 5, including jars, bottles and jugs.</p> <p>Aluminum and Metal Cans, Foil, Steel Bottle Caps</p> <p>Paper Products - newspaper, magazines, brochures, cardboard, paper towel and toilet paper rolls, paper bags, paperback and hard cover books, cartons, cards, junk mail, phone books, file folders, cardboard beverage carriers, dry food cartons, clean pizza boxes, etc.</p> <p>Leaves - twice a year on designated days, leaves placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up curbside. For 2022, leaf pick-up will be done on Nov. 7th and Dec. 5th, weather dependent. Residents may also bring leaves to the Township Recycling Center (see below) when Leaf/Brush area is open.</p> <p>Christmas Trees - will be picked up in January, date to be published on Township website. Typically this is in the middle of January. Please ensure lights, tinsels and any decorations are removed.</p>
<p>WHAT IS NOT PICKED UP CURBSIDE:</p>	<p>Items that are considered Garbage. Click here for link. #6 Foam Packaging (not clamshells or cups) can be brought to SCMUA for a nominal fee. #4 Plastic Shopping Bags, Dry Cleaning Bags, etc. can be brought to local stores like Shop-Rite, Stop & Shop and Weis Markets.</p>
<p>WHAT NEEDS TO BE BROUGHT TO SUSSEX COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SCMUA): 34 South Route 94, Lafayette, NJ 973-579-6998 Open Mon. to Sat. from 7am to 2pm</p>	<p>E Waste (ex. computers, printers, televisions, stereo equipment, VCRs, DVD and CD players, fax machines, copiers, radios and other electronic media) - See SCMUA flyer for dates.</p> <p>Hazardous Waste (ex. paints, oil, chemicals, insecticides, pesticides, driveway sealer, etc.) – SCMUA designates special free Hazardous Waste Disposal Days during the year. See SCMUA flyer for dates.</p> <p>Construction Materials (ex. concrete, sheetrock, tiles, wood, toilets, sinks, vanities, siding, flooring, shingles, siding, gutters, windows, railroad ties, etc.) can be brought year round to SCMUA for a nominal fee.</p> <p>#5 Rigid Plastics (ex. patio furniture, household plastic items like storage containers, tubs, shelving, milk crates, plastic toys such as little tykes, big wheels, plastic buckets) may be brought to SCMUA for disposal for a nominal fee.</p> <p>Other Items - fluorescent light bulbs, liquid medical waste or needles, car/boat/lawn tractor batteries, air conditioners, flags, etc. can be brought year round to SCMUA for a nominal fee.</p>
<p>NEED TO BRING TO BYRAM TWP. RECYCLING CENTER: 10 Mansfield Drive Stanhope, NJ 07874 973-347-2500x138 Open daily during daylight hours; Leaf and Brush area is closed during winter months (typically mid Dec. through end of March, weather dependent)</p>	<p>Metals (ex. appliances such as stove, dishwasher, microwave, etc.). Grills are accepted at the Recycling Center <u>after</u> the propane tank has been removed (<u>tanks are not accepted</u> in Byram, but may be brought to SCMUA for disposal).</p> <p>Auto Tires (With Rims Removed) - Byram Twp. will designate special days when Auto Tires may be accepted at the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center. Dates will be posted on our website. Tires can be brought to SCMUA year round with a disposal fee.</p> <p>Leaves - Although leaves placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up curbside during special Leaf pick-up days (see website for dates), residents (NOT contractors) may bring leaves to the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open during daylight hours 7 days a week. Note that this area is monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with security cameras. Typically this area is closed from mid Dec. through the end of March due to winter weather conditions. However, there is the possibility that this area may close earlier than mid Dec. and/or may not open till late April as this is dependent upon the weather. Please call the Township to confirm the dates this area will close and open. Grass clippings are NOT accepted and must be brought to SCMUA.</p> <p>Brush - brush/branches less than 4" in diameter can be brought to the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open. See "Leaves" for dates/times. Note that brush is a separate area from leaves. Grass clippings are NOT accepted and must be brought to SCMUA.</p> <p>Medical Waste - pills, tablets and capsules can be recycled at the Byram Twp. Police Dept. Liquids and needles (sharps) need to be brought to SCMUA.</p> <p>Cell Phones/Rechargeable Batteries - can be recycled at Byram Twp. Municipal Building.</p>
