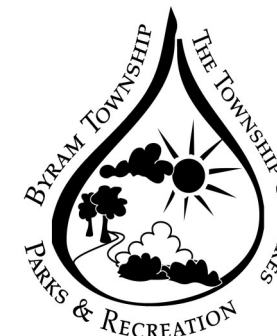

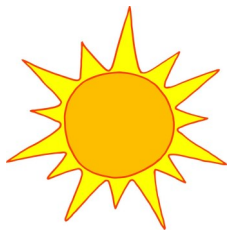

In this engineering camp, you will have fun integrating Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics by building and designing a wide range of gadgets, inventive machines, towers, crazy contraptions, and more. Projects include: The Great Tower Challenge, The Standing Cup Pyramid Challenge, Wooden Coaster Challenge, Structural Engineering Challenge, Magnificent Marble Machine, and a host of other fun contests designed to bring out the engineer in you! *please note this program is for ages 7-12

Battle-Bots & Robotic Fun **Dates: July 16-19, 2018**
Have fun building and creating using your imagination. Campers will construct a wide range of robot projects throughout the week. Projects will include constructing a Battle-Bot from our huge Robotix modular collection, participating in our robot tug-o' war, Olympic competition, soccer match, and more.
